

The European Society for Composite Materials invites submissions for the ESCM Award

The ESCM Award recognizes the accomplishments of a young researcher who has made significant contributions in the field of Composite Materials.

Award presentation will be made during the 15th European Conference on Composite Materials (ECCM-15), to be held in Venice (Italy), June 24-28, 2012.

The following criteria will be used in selecting the recipient:

- age below 35,
- work in the area of composite materials in a laboratory or a university in Europe,
- work that has made a significant academic or industrial impact.

The recipient of the award will give a plenary conference presentation during ECCM-15, all his/her expenses related to participation in ECCM-15 are covered by ESCM, and the recipient will also receive a certificate in recognition of the award.

Please send a CV, the list of written publications (separate: IF papers – papers i.e. those which have Impact Factors – books and chapters, patents, conference papers), the list of independent citations not including self citations (separate those, which are in the SCI – Science Citation Index – database), a two-page description of the work and accomplishments, and a selection of your five most significant papers by February 1st 2012 by e-mail to:
